Tips to help plan your Smart-home during the pre-wire stage:

- Make a list of zones within the home.
- Think of services and equipment you would like to access in the zone (i.e. TV's, Projectors, Speakers, Smart-lighting, Touch-screens, WiFi access points etc).
- If you feel you don't immediately require a service, but might at a later stage, ensure the necessary cabling is installed during the pre-wire stage, as this will eliminate the need for costly retrofit work later down the track.
- Visualize where technology will reside, this will indicate where wall-plates and outlets need to be installed, and what styles and colour schemes would fit in with the rest of your house.
- Consider the most logical locations for CCTV, security and access control hardware to be installed, to avoid delays in the event of an emergency or invasion.
- Ensure cabling is installed safely, securely and in accordance with rules and regulations to avoid electrical hazards, interference and damage.
